

## Crofton Match Play Championship



**Crofton Match Play Championship (August 8-10)**, format is head-to-head match play. The Championship Bracket is made of 16 spots or seeds. Seeds 1 and 2 go to the previous year's Men's Club Champion and Runner-up, respectively. Seeds 3 through 6 are comprised of the top four finishers in the Stroke Play Championship held in May. Seeds 6-16 (10 spots) are filled by the top 10 qualifying round totals from the established qualifying period.

All players who intend to qualify **must notify the pro shop of their "intent to qualify" by July 9<sup>th</sup>**. Any notices of intent received after the 9<sup>th</sup> will be ineligible for qualifying with no exceptions. The Qualifying Period is from Saturday, July 12<sup>th</sup> through Sunday, July 27<sup>th</sup>. Similar to the Stroke Play Championship, all male golfers and juniors with a July 1 USGA Handicap Index of 10.0 or lower may attempt to qualify for the Match Play Championship Bracket. Qualification requires each participant to play two rounds from the Championship Tees under USGA Rules of Golf. The combined score will be compared to the combined score of all other players attempting to qualify, with the 10 best scores qualifying into seeds 6-16 of the Match Play Championship Bracket. In order for a round to be considered an eligible qualifying round, the player must check in with the pro shop, declare his intent to qualify, receive his official scorecard, and must play the qualifying round from the black tees with another member of the club who will keep score.
