



This is an important message for all junior golfers (Anyone under the age of 18).

Now that the summer is upon us, we have lots of people who are trying to get out and use the golf course. We are currently experiencing some confusion with everyone understanding our junior golf rules and regulations.

We want everyone to have access to the course under the correct guidelines and regulations established in the clubs By-Laws. Below is a list of regulations that all Junior golfers must follow when coming to the course to play.

The purpose in this message is to clearly lay out the expectations for junior golf play from this point forward. If you have a son or daughter who plays golf....please take a moment to make sure that they are and will continue to follow the below listed regulations.

We appreciate your understanding and support in this matter.

Junior Golf Rules & Regulations

1. Play & Practice

Everyone **must check in** when arriving at the course. This includes play and practice and is applicable to all golfers regardless of age!

Juniors **may not** make tee times. Only full privilege members may make tee times. Juniors may accompany a full privilege golfer on a tee time, however, if there are no adults playing in the group juniors are only eligible to walk on. Junior will be placed into a tee time once they are at the course and waiting to play.

2. Dress Code

Proper attire is essential to preserve the integrity and tradition of the game and the club. Golf Shirts must be tucked in and slacks or shorts must be presentable. Golf shoes with soft spikes or flat soled sneakers are required. (No denim, pool attire, or workout apparel may be worn at anytime in the golf services area.)

3. Guest Policy

Every Junior golfer is entitled to bring out one guest per month. The posted guest rates apply. Guests are only permitted to use the practice range and facilities with the member prior to play of round.

4. Practice

Juniors must follow the guidelines established on the practice area. Please read the large board for the specific rules regarding practice in the practice areas.
