Swimming Pool Rules and Regulations

1. Lifeguards must be on duty and the pool officially open before swimmers are allowed in the water.
2. Guests must be accompanied by a member at all times. The Member must sign in the guest and be charged the appropriate guest fee. Rain checks do not apply.
3. Members must sign in with the guard/greeter and present their Crofton Country Club issued identification card.
4. Members will be held accountable for the actions of their guests. Inappropriate behavior will not be tolerated. Offenders will be asked to leave the facility and face possible revocation of membership without refund.
5. The pool may be closed at times for mechanical failure, operational problems or inclement weather. The decision is at the sole discretion of the pool management.
6. All swimmers must shower before entering the pool. Showers and sanitary facilities are provided.
7. The club will not be responsible for the loss or damage of personal property. Members and guests using the pool, diving board, slide, playground equipment and other club facilities do so at their own risk.
8. Children under the age of 13 must be accompanied by an adult or a responsible person over the age of 18 authorized by the minor's parents in writing. If the child is in the main pool the guardian must be in the immediate vicinity unless the child is a proven swimmer as determined by pool management. Members and guests of any age take full responsibility for their own safety.
9. A parent or guardian must closely watch children at all times while in the pool or in the facility. Parent or guardian must accompany non-swimmers in the water at all times.
10. For the purpose of supporting non-swimmers, inner tubes, water rings and all other flotation devices are not permitted at any time. For safety purposes, only a life vest approved by the U.S. Coast Guard is to be used. If a child uses such a life vest, a parent or guardian must accompany the child in the water at all times.
11. Only food and beverages purchased from the club is allowed in the pool area. Food is restricted to the picnic areas and snack bar patio area. No Food is allowed on the pool deck area. Members are responsible for cleaning up after themselves and their children.
12. No Glass of any type is allowed in the pool area or restrooms.
13. Members and guests in the pool area must be dressed in proper swimming attire. No cut-offs, thongs, gym shorts or extraordinary revealing swim attire will be allowed.

14. Adult swim is for those 18 years and older and will be scheduled at the 45 minute mark of each hour beginning at noon for a duration of 15 minutes. No children are permitted in the pool at this time even in the care of an adult.
15. The baby pool is reserved for children 6 years old and younger. Children in the baby pool must be under constant adult supervision. Lifeguards are not responsible for supervision of the baby pool. If inappropriate behavior is exhibited at any time, notify a lifeguard.
16. Children with diapers or who are not completely toilet trained are not permitted in the main pool. This includes swim diapers or wet pants. Parents take full responsibility for adhering to this rule. If a child creates an "accident" in the main pool the parents may be subject to any and all costs incurred as a result of the closing the pool for proper treatment of the water and cleaning.
17. Person with infectious diseases, bandages, open wounds or sores or under the influence of alcohol or drugs are not permitted in the pool.
18. No running, shoving, rough play or actions deemed dangerous by the lifeguards will be tolerated in the pool, facilities or deck.
19. Starting blocks are to be used during swim team competition only.
20. Swimmers are not permitted to hang on or play around the ladders or steps.
21. Only one person is allowed on the diving board and slide at a time. Parents are responsible for their child's ability to use the diving board and slide.
22. Diving sideways, inappropriate running unsafe behavior or excessive bouncing on the diving board is prohibited and may result in suspension of use for that swimmer.
23. When a swimmer from the diving board or slide surfaces, they must immediately swim to the nearest ladder and exit the diving well. Only at that time may another swimmer use the slide or diving board.
24. Swimming is not allowed in the diving well unless the diving board and slide are closed and the lifeguard has opened the well for swimming.
25. Swimmers must be aware of swimmers in the lap lane and yield to them. Diving into the lap lane is never permitted as well as other shallow areas of the pool.
26. The office telephone is for emergency and official use only.
27. Any questions in regard to the pool rules should be discussed with the General Manager of the Country Club.
