



Dear Susan,

My name is Ryan Rubush. I am the head coach of the Crofton Country Club swim team, and run the lesson program as well. This will be my fourth year coaching, and I have been teaching lessons similar to a program I used to teach under called Swim America for several years. I swam middle-distance freestyle for Towson University (NCAA Div. 1) up until this spring. I am pursuing an exercise science/pre-med degree from Towson, and will be going into my senior year this September. My assistant coach will be the other swim instructor. She is currently swimming for a club team, but has been recruited to swim for University of Delaware (also NCAA Div.1) this fall. We will be teaching group lessons together, and will both be available individually for private lessons.

Swim Lesson Requirements

Child must be potty trained- no diapers or swim diapers allowed.

The child must be at least 4 years old to be in group lessons, but any age is fine for private lessons.

Private lessons

\$25 for a half hour of one-on-one instruction, which I have found to be much more effective.

Group lessons

starts June 15

Beginners are 11am

Advanced at 12pm.

\$45 for 4 days

Monday - Thursday

(Friday is make up day for inclement weather)

35-45 minutes in length

Groups will consist of no more than 10 kids, and there will be two instructors.

Beginners (anywhere from just able

If you have two children, or friends who would like to do lessons together, the rate is \$40 for a half hour of one-on-two instruction.

(If the children are far apart in age or skill level, I would not recommend this option.) Before June 15, I can give lessons any time before 6pm *(the closer to 5pm, the better).*

After June 15, any time after 1pm *(the closer to 1pm, the better).*

Availability will vary from week to week depending on my coaching schedule, but I also have time slots in the morning and at night occasionally, so if these times don't work with your schedule, feel free to ask.

If you schedule a lesson and don't call at least an hour ahead of time to cancel, you are still responsible for payment.

Advanced (able to swim the length of the pool or close).

Please note-

The first month fills up relatively quickly, so if you take a spot and realize you cant make it that week, let me know the weekend before so I can allow another child in the group, otherwise you will still be responsible for payment.

Private lessons for adults also, whether you are getting into lap swimming or training for a triathlon, adults usually benefit most from lessons.
